Getting Started...

Mailbags– Each day the children will bring home their papers in a zippered mailbag. Please return the bag **every** morning in their knapsacks. If you are sending notes or money to school, please use the mailbag. This system will ensure that important documents arrive safely.



Homework Books– Beginning today, the Grade Ones and Twos will be bringing home a red **Homework book** each night. While the amount of homework that the students receive is minimal this early in the year, the purpose of the book is to make the students responsible for **completing their homework, getting their book signed by you, and returning it to school the next day in their mailbags**. It is **their** job to do these things without constant reminders from you. By the time they reach the older grades, good habits will be in place regarding responsibility for doing things on their own. To encourage all of our students to complete this task, an incentive reward will be given on Fridays for the whole school.



Chime In Books – Each Friday, your child will bring home a yellow Chime In book that will contain a poem that the class has learned that week to share with you. Please return the book every Monday morning!



Lunches – Lunch is an exciting time in our class, but by the end of the day, no one remembers what they had to eat. Please put names on any plastic containers that you send to school for lunch so that you will see them again. Also, as a safety precaution, no glass bottles are to be sent in lunches. Thank you!



Gym – Our class will be having Gym on **Tuesday** and **Thursday** afternoons. Running shoes must be worn, but no gym uniforms are required in Grade One and Two.



Bible Verses: Each Monday, a Bible verse will be sent home with your child to be learned for the next Monday. Prizes will be awarded each term as an incentive for memorization, and it also appears as a mark on each term's report card.

Word Wall Words: Each Monday a list of five words will be sent home. We will be working with these sight words each day in class. Recognition of these popular words helps in reading fluency and writing proficiency.



Spelling: Each Monday a list of spelling words will be sent home with all **Grade One** and **Grade Two students**. Please review these words each evening with your child. Spelling Dictation will take place each Friday to see how well we have mastered these words.








Looking Ahead...
